Our 51 kids in our summer program are learning, creating arts and crafts, playing outdoor

games and - their favorite - swimming at the local pool. Our staff and volunteers plan the lessons and workshops in partnership with the Family Nutrition Program (a branch of Virginia Cooperative Extension) and the Alexandria Department of Community and Human Services. So far our kids have gone to the zoo, the American History museum and Luray Caverns, Great Falls, Botanical Gardens, and the National Geographic Museum. Each child receives a healthy meal and secure environment, with our staff and volunteers ensuring that every child has a fun and educational summer!

Coming up - the 2015-2016 school year is just around the corner and Community Lodgings is gearing up for another year of engaging, interactive after school programming!

The Youth Employment series of workshops ended with seven students placed in summer jobs with the City of Alexandria. During these workshops our students learned the employment process - how to set goals, make career choices, complete applications, interview (including how to dress for the interview and job), answer and ask questions, the importance of saving and general workplace etiquette. We are so proud of them as they put their new-found knowledge to work in their new (albeit short) careers as a records clerk, data entry, customer service, office assistant and a counselor in training.
